Position Summary:

The Hunting Guide will be responsible for conducting guided quail hunts at our 1,876 acre commercial hunting facility as well as the family hunting area in Brighton on an “as needed” basis. The hours will flex and include weekends as well as occasional holiday work.

Essential Functions:

- In cooperation with the Silver Lake Preserve Manager conduct quail hunts as needed.
- Communicate the hunting laws and safety procedures to customers to ensure compliance and safety.
- Assist guests with hunting gear and vehicles as needed.
- Maintain open and positive communications with all guests, manager and other team members to maximize the optimal experience of all hunting and or lodge guests. A good reputation brings customers back to experience another hunt.
- Be responsible for the safety of the party and be ready to administer first aid and handle emergencies as needed.
- Preserve, clean and prepare all game birds taken in hunt at the guest’s request.
- Clean and help maintain preserve fleet vehicles in good working order.
- Help, as needed, in the use and care of hunting dogs.
